- Re: HR Circular 028 2020: Temporary Variation in Terms and Conditions of Service and associated New Grades/Codes – Final Year (Academic Year 4) Nurse/Midwife Students in Response to COVID-19

Dear Colleagues,

Further to the HR memo of 7th April on the arrangements for the recording of Nursing and Midwifery Students (Years 1-3) temporarily hired as Health Care Assistants, I wish to now advise on the arrangements for the 4th Year cohort of Nursing and Midwifery internship students.

Further to the sanction received by the Department of Health, 4th Year Nursing and Midwifery internship students (pre-registration), currently on paid placement, will also be temporarily paid on the first point of the Health Care Assistant scale, for a period of 3 months, effective from April 14th 2020. The sanction is based on the uplift cost from the student nurse internship salary scale.

As this cohort are currently our employees, to enable this change, a Temporary Variation in the Terms and Conditions of Service gives effect to this change as follows:

1. This cohort shall continue in their existing placement location and shall be paid the HCA scale at point 1;

- 2. Appendix A sets out a communication to each nursing and midwifery internship student advising them of the Temporary Variation in the Terms and Conditions of Service. This must be provided by the relevant service (HR Lead/ Director of Nursing/ Midwifery) to each Nursing and Midwifery Internship Student to ensure that they are advised of the changes;
- 3. The change shall apply for 3 months only, effective from 14th April 2020 with no retrospection before this date. For any 4th year internship students commencing practice placement after this date, the 3-month period will still apply from the 14th April, with salary reflected from the date they actually commence in placement;
- 4. New grade codes have been sanctioned by the Department of Health to enable accurate reporting and recording of student nursing and midwifery interns (COVID-19 HCA), which are set out in Table A below. Please note that the change in grade code is necessary for subsequent financial allocation;
- 5. As a temporary change, automatic return to the grade codes for student nursing and midwifery interns (pre-registration) after the 3-month period (unless otherwise advised) is required. For ease Table B below provides the current grade codes for the student nursing and midwifery interns (pre-registration), and the new temporary codes for COVID-19 response;
- 6. The recording of the WTE value for this temporary change will be 100% of WTE value for the 3-month period only;
