Re: Mental Health nurse retirees who return to work – Pay arrangements

Dear Rosarii,

I am writing to you to convey the Minister's approval for a derogation from public service pay policy for mental health nurse retirees who return to work for the HSE, subject to the requirements set out in this letter.

Persons who are re-employed in the public service, following retirement from the public service, are normally assigned to the first point of the post 1 January 2011 salary scale in line with Government pay policy.

Having regard to the recruitment difficulties in the mental health services, the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform has sanctioned remuneration up to the long service increment (LSI) on the mental health nurse salary scale depending on relevant service. This sanction is conditional on normal abatement rules applying.

The sanction will take effect from the date of settlement of the current dispute between the HSE and the Psychiatric Nurses Association.
