### 4, Filling of Controller Vacancies:

To be filled as follows:

- > If vacancies still exist, the vacancies will be advertised by way of open competition

#### 5. Critical Incident Stress Debriefing:

With a view to developments already and in keeping with best practices of Training & Development Human Resources in the Health sector

In line with best practice and normal Health and Safety provisions, I feel that there should be two EMC staff per night shift in Control Centres where one Control/Command Centre operates per Health Board.

# 12. Implementation Date:

The overall implementation date of the Agreement, unless otherwise stated above, should be 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2001.
