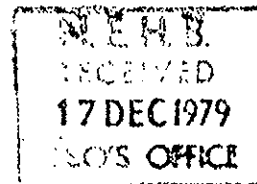

I am directed by the Minister for Health to convey approval to the following revised arrangements in respect of night duty and Saturday premium payments for general trained nurses.

Night Duty

A revised payment of $T + \frac{1}{4}$ to be made in respect of each hour rostered night duty worked, exclusive of overtime, to take effect from 1st January, 1979. This arrangement applies to grades rostered for night duty on a rotational basis. In relation to permanent night duty grades a revised payment of $T + \frac{1}{16}$ in respect of each hour rostered night duty worked, exclusive of overtime, should apply from 1st January, 1979. Calculations of arrears due should be based on difference between present method of payment and the revised method.

Saturday Premium

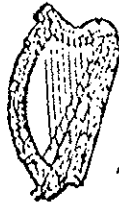
The present arrangement of £1 for work on Saturday where Saturday is part of normal working week is not to be changed. As an interim arrangement a lump sum of £40 on account may be made to general trained nurses who work on Saturdays as part of their normal roster. The Special Conciliation Committee is at present examining the premium payment payable in respect of Saturday work.

The estimated cost of the increases should be submitted on the attached form to the Finance Unit, Room 44, Custom House.

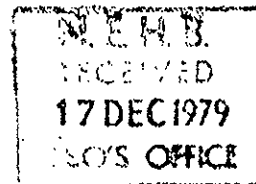
