Nursing Registration/Diploma Programmes

Dear

I am directed by the Minister for Health and Children to say that he has approved a number of improved financial supports for student nurses participating in the Nursing Registration/Diploma Programmes. Details of these are set out below:

Annual Maintenance Grant

An increase of £500 in the non-means tested maintenance grant, from £2,500 to £3,000 per annum, with effect from 1 March, 1998.

The appropriate financial adjustment will be included in your Board's revised determination which will be issued shortly.

External Clinical Placement Allowance

The introduction, with effect from 1 March, 1998, of an external clinical placement allowance of £20 per week. This allowance is to be paid to a student undertaking an external clinical placement for the duration of that placement in any case where-

- (a) it is necessary for the student to find accommodation away from his/her normal place of residence, and
- (b) the health board/hospital/agency is not in a position to provide such accommodation.

An external clinical placement is a period of clinical experience during which the student is assigned to a health facility other than where they are normally based for the purpose of gaining <u>specialised</u> clinical experience.

Travel Pass


The provision, with effect from 1 March, 1998, of a travel pass to a student undertaking an external clinical placement who does <u>not</u> require accommodation.

It should be noted that a student undertaking an-external clinical placement is to receive either the £20 allowance or a travel pass, but <u>not</u> both.

Please furnish as a matter of urgency detailed costings in relation to the payment of an external clinical placement allowance of £20 per week or the provision of a travel pass to student nurses undertaking external clinical placements. Full particulars of the external clinical areas to which student nurses are assigned and the duration of such placements should be given. On receipt of this information, a further appropriate adjustment will be made to your Board's financial allocation for 1998.
