Extension of time limits for access and reclamining prior services

I am directed by the Minister for Health and Children to refer to Circular 20/2005 issued on 23 December 2005.

Within the public health sector the Schemes covered by this circular include:

- The Local Government Supervision Scheme (LGSS)
- The Non-mixed Health Agencies Supervision Scheme (NHASS)
- The Voluntary Hospitals Supervision Scheme (VHSS)
- Model supervision schemes of Agencies under the aegis of the Department of Health and Children.

I wish to point out, on the time limits set out in paragraphs 21 and 23 of Circular 20/2005,

Access

Paragraph 21 sets an expiry deadline of ...
The option of access to a scheme referred to in paragraph 24 above will be available until 31 October 2006.
This time limit is hereby extended to 31 October 2007.

Reclamining of prior part-time services

Paragraphs 27 and 28 set a deadline for reclamining prior service ...
for serving employees, the consequences of paragraph 36(a), 32(6)(b) or 32(6)(c), as appropriate, regarding payment of 'back' contributions will be available until 30 June 2009 on the date of publication of circular.

The time limit for payment of all block contributions is hereby extended to 30 June 2000 or the date of retirement (whichever is later).

Please note

In the case of former part-time employees who were serving on or after 31 April 1996 / 20 December 2001, as appropriate, and who had retired before the date of issue of this circular (December 2005), the block contribution must be paid at the time of opting into the relevant scheme. There is no change in this provision.

All other conditions remain as set out in Circular 2000/04.
