REMUNERATION OF DIRECTOR OF NURSING/MATRON GRADES

I am directed by the Minister for Health to refer to the recent agreement reached between employers and unions representing nursing grades in relation to their claim for a special pay increase under the Programme for Competitiveness and work. In relation to the grades Director of Nursing/Matron the agreement provides for a revised and rationalised structure being introduced to replace previous arrangements under which salary scales were determined historically on the basis of factors such as bed numbers. Revised scales for all posts are based on inclusive salaries for the role and responsibilities attaching to the posts. No additional payments by way of premium payments for attendance at weekends, nights or bank holidays are payable. Accordingly, in circumstances where staff at Director of Nursing/Matron level are currently in receipt of premium payments for weekend, bank holiday or night attendance arrangements must be put in place to terminate this practice no later than the date of implementation of the revised scales now approved. The overall national criteria for the classification of posts within the five pay band/salary structure is as follows:

Posts in Band 1 must satisfy all of the following criteria:

- Activity levels at 20,000 patients per annum (through combination of in-patient admissions and day eases:
- Full recognition for pre-registration nurse training;
- Responsibility for 200 nursing staff or over:
- Accident and Emergency Department with over 15,000 attendances per annum.

Posts in Band 2 must satisfy the following criteria:

- Activity levels above 10,000 patients per annum (through combination of in-patient admissions and day cases)
- Responsibility for 100 nursing staff or more

Hawkins House Dublin 2

Posts in Band 3 must satisfy the following criteria:

Activity levels above 1,000 in-patient admissions per annum

Posts in Band 4 must satisfy the following criteria:

• Hospital budget in 1996 in excess of £1 million or additional responsibilities attached to the Matron post which involve responsibility for services provided at other geographical locations.

Posts in Band 5:

• Remaining District Hospitals

Having regard to the nature of Director of Nursing/Matron posts in mental handicap service it has been agreed that a separate band/salary scales will be introduced for those in Director of Nursing/Matron posts in mental handicap agencies. Accordingly, in relation to posts where the Director of Nursing/Matron has responsibility for a full nurse training school or where the budget for 1996 is in excess of £5 million a salary scale maximum of £31,000 at 1 June 1997 is being introduced. Others posts should be categorised on the basis of the criteria in respect of Bands 4 and 5 as set out above.

For the purposes of rationalisation the top Director of Nursing/Matron posts in mental handicap agencies will be classified as Band 2A of the new national structure. Other posts would be classified as appropriate (typically band 4 or 5).

The sanction of the Minister may be assumed for the implementation of the revised salary scales as set out at the appendix attached. Allocations will be adjusted in due course to take account of the costs involved. Details should be included with your agency's claim in respect of the adjustments for nurses generally. Agencies are requested to treat as a matter of urgency implementation of the revised scales and payment of retrospection. Where it is not possible to pay full retrospective elements before mid April, each agency is advised that an appropriate "down payment" on the retrospective element may be paid.
