#### Extended Duty Liability effective from 1 July 1999

A flat payment of £3,692 will be paid to each consultant with on-call liability.

#### Emergency Services effective from 1 July 1999

Scale of fees for call-outs arising after the completion of the scheduled commitment

- (a) £39.02 per call-out for each patient
- (b) in the event of the call-out taking place after midnight or extending beyond that time, the call-out fee will be £51.97
- in the event of the call extending beyond one hour's duration from leaving home until return, a further sum of £25.95 for each hour or part hour is payable.

The upper amount payable to any one indivdual is subject to an upper limit of £4,925 in any one calendar year.

To each of these figures there falls to be added a sum of £10,286 effective from 1 July 1999 being the annual value of ten additional hours per week at the end of the scheduled commitment as provided for in section 4.2 of the Interim Report.

#### 'B' Factor effective from 1 July 1999

£39.02 per 24 hour period or a proportionate sum of any greater or lessor period; the annual amount payable to any one individual is subject to an upper limit of £3,902.

#### 'C' Factor effective from 1 July 1999

£39.02 per call out to each patient; in the event of the call out taking place after midnight or extending beyond that time, the figure is £51.97; in the event of the call out extending beyond one hour's duration from leaving home until return, a further sum of £25.95 for each hour or part hour is payable; the annual amount payable to any one individual is subject to an upper limit of £3,902 in any one calendar year.

#### **Pensions**

- (a) Retired Consultants who did not hold the 1991 revised common contract receive the figure of £65,275 abated by 10%, 15%, 20% as appropriate, plus an extended duty liability factor of £3,692 based on the adjusted figure of £53,040 per annum (item 6, Appendix C of 1991 Contract), effective from 1 July 1999
- (b) Retired Consultants who held the 1991 revised common contract and retired prior to 31 December 1997 receive an increase of **1.5**% from **1 July 1999**.
