A Chara,

I am directed by the Minister for Health and Children to refer to the Annex to the Agreement on Pay and Conditions of Employment between the Irish Congress of Trade Unions and Employers Organisations which forms part of Partnership 2000 for Inclusion, Employment and Competitiveness with regard to Non-nursing Personnel.

In accordance with Clause 3 of the Annex, sanction is hereby given for the implementation of Phase II of the Agreement i.e. an increase of 2.25% of basic weekly pay with effect from 1 July 1998. Full details of the revised payscales are provided overleaf.

Agencies are reminded that no offers or commitments whatever can be made at any stage with regard to special increases, or for improvements or in conditions of employment of any grade, group or individual, without prior consultation with the Department.
