## Revision of Remuneration for Certain Non-Nursing Staff under Craftworkers' Analogue Agreement

I am directed by the Minister for Health and Children to refer to the recent agreement reached with the non-nursing group of unions in relation to revised remuneration to certain non-nursing grades in order to maintain their 80% pay relationship with the craftsmen grade.

The Minister's sanction may be assumed for the payment of the revised remuneration, for the grades involved as attached at Appendices 1 - 4.

You should ensure that arrangements are made for the payment of the revised remuneration as soon as possible. It is incumbent on both sides to discuss at a very early date

- 1. The development of voluntary codes of practice regarding the maintenance of essential services during industrial disputes.
- the signing up of Unions to both a Health and Local Authority National Council.

Your agency's determination will be adjusted when the claim costing form (see Appendix 5) is returned and verified. The completed claim should be returned to your Health Board / ERHA (where appropriate) or to David Maguire, Department of Health and Children, Personnel Management & Development, 4th Floor, Hawkins House, Dublin 2.
