DID YOU KNOW THAT It is estimated that 1 in 3 road collisions per year involve people driving for work at the time of the collision. In a recent report of fatal collisions on the road Drummond (2016) reports that 23% of road traffic fatalities were work related (Ref: *Drummond, A. (2016) Fatal collisions on the road and safety and health, IOSH*)
